Mission:

Loyola Sacred Heart Catholic High School pledges to teach, model, and promote the Gospel values rooted in Catholic principles and traditions in an environment of academic excellence.

School Characteristics:

Loyola Sacred Heart is a diocesan Catholic, co-educational high school committed to providing a high quality college preparatory education in an environment of traditional Catholic teaching. In 2009 – 2010, it entered its 136th year of academic excellence with an enrollment of 205 students, of which approximately 70% are Catholic. Located in Missoula, Montana, a university community of approximately 75,000 in the mountains of Western Montana, Loyola Sacred Heart provides the only Catholic secondary education in the region.

Academic Requirements:

The teaching faculty includes twenty-three members, many of whom have been recognized locally, regionally, and nationally for their teaching excellence from such organizations as NEH, International Science Engineering Fair, National Presidential Scholars, Wal-Mart Regional, and NCCE. Each faculty member is a licensed teacher from the state of Montana. The average Loyola Sacred Heart faculty member has been teaching sixteen years, with 60% having earned a graduate degree, including one doctorate.

The academic year at Loyola Sacred Heart is divided into two semesters, offering 36 weeks of instruction. There are eight course offerings in the block schedule. Each student must satisfactorily complete a minimum of 24 core credits (plus electives) and 100 volunteer service hours in order to graduate and receive a diploma.
